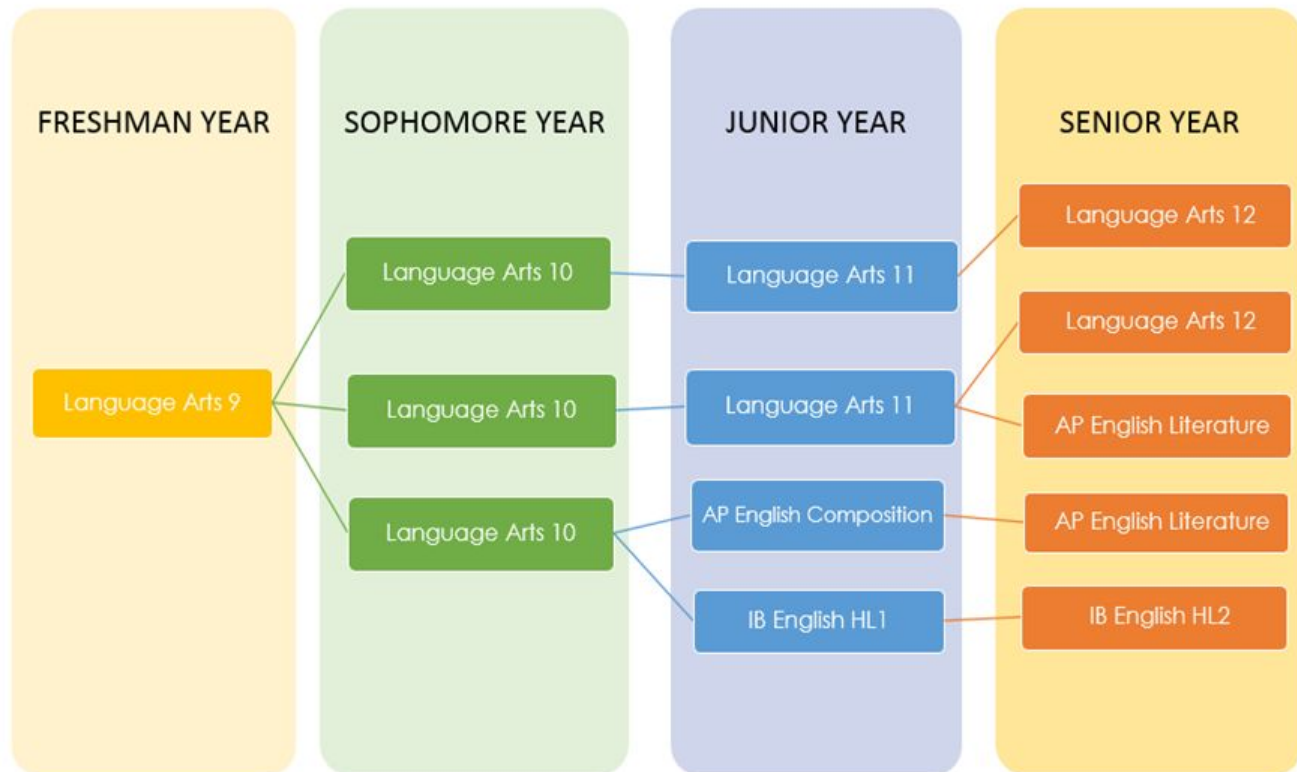

CHOOSE WISELY!

Schedule Adjustments are made for the following reasons:

- Schedule is incomplete (does not have all 7 hours scheduled)
- There is a scheduled conflict (two classes are scheduled in the same hour)
- The Student previously failed or did not take the prerequisite course
- The Student is missing a course needed to fulfill a graduation requirement

Process:

- Deadline for notifications of errors is the end of the first week of a new semester
- A digital schedule error form will be available in the fall
