Scholarship Application Requirements:

- **ALL** graduating seniors living within the Oxford (**Michigan**) School District or attending an Oxford, Michigan area school are encouraged to apply.
- Grade point average of at least a 2.0 based on a 4.0 scale is required.
- Scholarships can be used for community college, trade school, college, or university.

Submit the Following Items:

- Cover sheet: Include your name only on the cover sheet. **DO NOT** put your name on any of the other pages of your application.
- Page 2: A list of your interests/activities: school, community, church, jobs, sports, etc.
- Page 3 and additional pages as needed: Answer the questions below.
